



COVID-19, HYBRID VIRTUAL LEARNING & BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS for 2020-2021

Many of the Public, Charter, and Private Schools in the Lehigh Valley have decided to return to school using a hybrid option that provides for two days of classroom instruction, two days virtual instruction, and one day of no instruction. The plans vary according to public school districts, charter schools, and private schools.

Because of CDC guidelines being followed by the schools there may not be enough space to accommodate all the children requiring care before/after school or on the days that schools are using virtual instruction or there is no instruction.

Creative Kids Club is preparing to help parents faced with this problem. However, we have limited space too! We are creating an area that will be used for children for virtual learning and we will have it staffed with personnel that can provide academic support to the children while they are attending their classes virtually.

Children will be in an area only used by them. They will be socially distanced by 6 feet, be required to a mask all day (as will staff assigned to the area), and their temperature will be taken when they arrive, at noon, and at departure (if the temperature exceeds 100.4 degrees they will immediately be isolated and sent home). There will also be hand sanitizer provided in the area, and children will be constantly reminded to wash their hands throughout the day.

The area also has Wi-Fi Services so the children can use their chrome books, notebooks, laptops, or tablets to accomplish their lessons. Parents are required to provide headphones so the other children in the area will not be disturbed. Also, please understand that the children in this area will range from Kindergarten through sixth grade.
